Day 1 Antalya

Arrive in Istanbul and meet your English speaking assistance and transfer to domestic terminal for your flight to Antalya. Antalya is Turkey's principal holiday resort in the Mediterranean region (ancient Pamphilia), is an attractive city with shady palm-lined boulevards, a prize-winning marina on the Mediterranean. In the picturesque old quarter, Kaleici, narrow winding streets and old wooden houses about the ancient city walls.

Arrive in Antalya and transfer to hotel in Antalya.

Day 2 Free day in Antalya

OR optional tour of Perge and Aspendos. Visit the Pamphilian city of **Perge**. Enter the city through the famous Hellenistic Gate and visit the Agora, the Bath Complex and the Nymphaeum. The city was first captured by Alexander the Great and it was dominated by the Selouks, the Kingdom of Pergamum and Rome respectively. Its Theater of Hellenistic-Roman type which was constructed in the 2nd century is capable of accommodating 15,000 people. Here, the gladiator fights had taken place during the late Roman period.

Continue to **Aspendos** to admire the magnificent theater with its unique acoustics and Roman Aqueduct. The city founded by colonist who came from Argos, has the best-preserved ancient theatre in Turkey. This famous theatre, dedicated to Emperor Markus Aurelius is without doubt one of the most magnificent Roman buildings in Pamphilia and it is still useable today with a seating capacity of 20,000 people. Aspendos had the distinction of being the only city besides Side that coined money in its own name at that early period.

Day 3 Golf

Day 5	Golf
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Early morning drive to National Golf Course (www.nationalturkey.com). English Speaking assistance will be with you at the golf course.

National was built in landscaped gardens and is surrounded by pine and eucalyptus forests.



The British styled Clubhouse has a peaceful atmosphere and panoramic views of the golf course.

At the National, the 18 hole Championship Course is 6279 meters, par 72 and designed by Ryder Cup Player David Feherty, has played host to the PGA European Turkish Seniors Open in 1996 and 1997. David Feherty has incorporated aspects of the best courses he has competed

on in the world, and has ensured that no two holes are similar. Carved through a forest of eucalyptus and pine trees with the back-drop of the snow capped Taurus Mountains and an abundance of natural lakes, the National will test players of all abilities.

The National thanks to David Jones, Senior Player, whom leading his consultancy since the beginning of the National to improve the conditions and design of the course.

Free day in Antalya OR optional tour of Myra, Demre and Kekova Island



After breakfast, drive to **Myra** features some of the most impressive and well preserved Lycian monuments in the country. These include an excellent collection of rock tombs and an imposing 2nd century theater.

Many of the tombs have log cabin features carved into the rock, presumably reflecting the domestic architecture of the period. A few easily accessible ones have inscriptions in the Lycian language. Carvings above are mostly in poor repair but the overall effect of this jumble of the architecture of death is dramatic.

The theater, like many others in major Roman cities, was later converted into an arena for gladiator fights and wild animal shows. Many carvings and inscriptions in the theater are still visible, and cavernous tunnels and access ways to the side have been cleared. While much of the seating is intact, the stage building is partly collapsed. A macabre set of three carved masks, presumably from the frieze, lies among the jumble of remains in the approach to the theater.

Then take a boat from the harbor of Demre to visit Kekova (Sunken City). Along the stony coastline the boatman may stop at a cave, or point out the occasional goat or the smoldering pyramids of wood used by peasants to make charcoal, the product may sit in plastic sacks at the water's edge, waiting to be taken away.

Along the edge of the island facing the mainland lie the fascinating half-submerged remains of a Lycian sunken city, and probably from Byzantine times later on. Signs warn against skin-diving, so you can not swim here because many foreigners in the past took a piece of ancient relics with them as a souvenir. The boatman will allow the passengers on board off for a swim further to the west, where the remains of a Byzantine chapel stand on the beach and where further sunken remains can be explored at ease by the swimmer with mask and snorkel.
